

FAQ for Registration and Events

Terms and Conditions

Please visit ksbe.edu/alumnireunion for additional and up-to-date information.

Registration Opens April 1, 2026 at 9:00am (Hawaii time), closes April 15, 2026 (or as events sell out). Registration link will be sent via email in March.

Out of respect for the safety and well-being of all in attendance, all guests will be required to adhere to the following KS event guidelines:

- Individuals who develop any symptoms of illness are asked to stay home.
- There will be no consumption of alcohol on campus.
- Parking for on campus events will be at Hale Ho'okū Ka'a Parking Structure. Shuttle buses to events will be provided, unless otherwise specified.
- Security and/or event staff reserve the right to refuse entry, or ask any guest to leave campus, if they refuse to abide by safety guidelines.

Cancellation Policy:

- Contact Alumni Relations at (808) 534-8283 or alumnievents@ksbe.edu by April 30 to receive a full refund. Beginning May 1, cancellation requests will not be refunded, except for emergencies. Ticket transfers and resale will be directed to Class Representatives.

Photography & Filming: Your attendance at any reunion event indicates your consent, waiver, and release to Kamehameha Schools.

**Our intent is to host this event as we have outlined above. If unforeseen circumstances require us to adjust these plans, we will be sure to communicate that as quickly as possible.*

Q: I haven't gotten an email about the Alumni Reunion and registration. Why?

A: E kala mai, we do our best to keep our contact information for Alumni as up to date as possible. Please contact us at alumnievents@ksbe.edu and we would be happy to resend you the Alumni Reunion registration information. And please remember to keep us up to date on any changes to your information!

Q: How do I register online?

A: Our registration platform is linked to our online community [Lei Hali'a Aloha](#). You will receive an email with a registration link. Registration is tied to the email address of the alumni registrant. Classmates married to each other should register under their own name and email, especially celebrants who are eligible to purchase restricted tickets (i.e. Kūpuna Pā'ina and Lū'au), regardless of who is processing the payment.

Q: My spouse and I share an email, or I do not use email. How can I purchase tickets?

A: Please contact the Alumni Relations office, alumnievents@ksbe.edu or (808)534-8283, for kōkua on how to register.

Q: Can I call to reserve my tickets and pay for them later?

A: 'A 'ole. All tickets must be purchased online and paid for via credit card through the secure registration website. Tickets are sold first-come, first-served, and the best way to ensure your ticket(s) is to complete your purchase online, we appreciate your understanding.

Q: Can I purchase tickets for my spouse, children, or classmates, if they are also celebrating?

A: 'Ae! Some events are only visible to eligible classes (e.g. Lū'au – 1s & 6s; Kūpuna Pā'ina – 1976 and older; Class of 2021 Pā'ina – 2021), so tickets should be purchased under the name, email, and class year of the registrant. If you do not meet the criteria for those tickets, they will not appear as options to purchase.

Q: Does the Lū'au ticket include the mākeke and Country Store?

A: 'Ae! Your Lū'au ticket is inclusive of the mākeke. If you do not have a ticket for Lū'au, you are still welcome to shop the mākeke, Country Store, and purchase pūpū (if available), but you will not be allowed seating in Kekūhaupī'o Gym once food service has begun.

***Q: The website does not seem to accept my registration, I've tried 3 times! What do I do?**

***A:** Due to the high volume of activity, the website may not refresh or update as quickly as it usually does. **DO NOT** attempt to make your purchase more than once; multiple transactions have to be manually refunded and disrupt our ticket count. Please contact the Alumni Office, (808) 534-8283 to confirm if your original attempt was successful or to re-register.

Q: How will I receive my Lū'au tickets?

A: We are stepping into the digital age! Your email confirmation will be your ticket for events. There will also be an accompanying QR Code that will access all of your purchases. **DO NOT share your email with your guests.** Your guests must be present with you to check in or you must provide their name at the time of registration so they can check in themselves. If your guest(s) check in the whole party without you, you may not be able to enter the event.

Q: How many tickets may I purchase?

A: Every eligible Kamehameha Schools celebrating graduate alumni* is eligible to purchase a maximum of two (2) tickets for Lū'au** and Kūpuna Pā'ina**. If you have a caregiver or need additional assistance, please contact Alumni Relations before you purchase your tickets, as we have set aside tickets for those needs. Other events may be open for additional ticket sales, including to non-celebrants and non-graduates.

**Non-graduates are welcome to attend the Kapālama Lū'au as a guest, however, they are not eligible to purchase tickets. Non-grads may purchase tickets to other events when available.*

***As long as there are tickets available.*

Q: Can I attend events on neighbor islands?

A: Hiki nō! All alumni are welcome to attend events on Maui and Hawai'i island. We invite you to huaka'i with your class and/or 'ohana. Your participation at neighbor island events supports our KSAA Regions, campuses, and communities. The more the merrier!

Q: I don't see a class night option, do you have anything planned?

A: Class Night is planned by your class. Alumni Relations has minimal details about class night events. You should check with your class representatives/class officers for more information.

Q: I missed registration! Can I still buy tickets after April 15?

A: Tickets will be sold during the registration window (April 1-15, 2026) or until events are sold out, whichever comes first. While we expect the Kapālama Lū'au to sell out, tickets for other events may still be available online or at the door. Please do not wait to purchase your tickets!

Q: I lost my email confirmation!

A: Please contact us at alumnievents@ksbe.edu at least 48 hours ahead of the event and we will resend your confirmation. You will also receive a reminder email 1 week prior to the start of Reunion, and three (3) days prior to individual events you have purchased. **Please double check that it is not going to your spam or junk mail.**

Q: What if I can no longer attend, will I receive a refund? When will I receive my refund?

A: We are very sorry you won't be able to join us. All cancellations made by April 30 will be honored with a full refund. **Cancellations requests made beginning May 1, 2026 will not be refunded.** Any ticket transfers or resale will be directed to your class representatives. You can also utilize the discussion feature on the registration website to connect with classmates to transfer or resell your tickets. Cancellations due to illness or emergency circumstances will be honored on a case-by-case basis. Mahalo for your understanding.

Q: I plan to travel to Hawaii from out-of-state. Will boarding on campus be offered?

A: A limited number of rooms will be available in the Middle School Dorms for the **celebrating classes in the “1s” and “6s” from 1951 through 1976**. All guests staying in the dorms will be required to complete a background check against the Hawai‘i No Harm to Student Registry prior to their arrival on campus, no exceptions. We encourage all our Alumni to utilize our hotel partners—information about preferred partners is available on Lei Hali‘a Aloha (alumni.ksbe.edu), or by contacting alumni@ksbe.edu.

Q: Will there be beverages available for purchase at the on-campus events?

A: ‘A ‘ole. There will be no sales or consumption of alcohol at any on-campus events. No outside alcohol and no kegs or large deliveries of alcohol will be allowed on campus. There can be no signage promoting alcohol. Alcohol purchased at an off-campus event may not be brought back onto campus. Please plan for a designated driver when needed—if alumni are unable to drive themselves, a Taxi/car share service will be called to transport them safely home at their expense. Alcohol that is brought to Alumni Reunion events will be removed and disposed of, and alumni and their guests may be asked to leave the event.
