<u>Please submit a separate Special Care Plan form for each type of condition.</u> If at any time during the school year your child develops a change, please submit a new or updated Special Care Plan to the preschool.

Kamehameha Schools Preschools staff will not administer any medication with the exception of an epinephrine auto-injector, e.g. EpiPen; students with a known severe allergy should provide an epinephrine auto-injector to be kept at school.
